FEE ITALY

FEE Italy started in 1987 as a non-profit organization and implements at a national level the following FEE Programmes: Blue Flag, Eco-Schools, and Young Reporters for the Environment, Learning about Forests and Green Key.

The Eco-Schools Programme is being implemented since 1998. Currently there are 240 participant schools, 74 of which have been awarded the Green Flag. In total the Programme engages 45,000 students, 600 teachers and also 25 local authorities.

FEE Italy is responsible for the formation of the teachers and supports the school in the activation of the local strategy necessary to make the program effective. All the schools work in local networks, which are part of a bigger national network.

The Italian Eco-Schools Programme offers the following themes: water, waste, energy, nature and biodiversity, transport and climate change.

FEE Italy also gives support to the schools for promote Local Agenda 21 and assists Eco-Schools in the actions of the forum when Local Agenda 21 already exists.

The Environment and Innovation Programme was started in November 2007. 17 Italian Eco-Schools have presented their projects and 3 of them were awarded.
