The Environment and Innovation Project – Launch: November 28

The "Environment and Innovation" is a project to encourage Eco-Schools to come up with innovative and creative solutions to environmental problems. Winning entries receive a grant to help them put their ideas into action and work with the local community to tackle Climate Change issues.

The new two-year cycle on "Climate Change: Let's Save Energy!" is active in six countries:

- Denmark,
- Finland,
- Italy,
- Norway,
- Turkey and
- Portugal.

The project is set up by FEE – Foundation for Environmental Education / Eco-Schools Programme International Co-ordination with support from Toyota Motor Europe, via the Toyota Fund for Europe.

The aim of the project is to promote innovation and environmental problem-solving amongst schools. The project operates at two levels: National and International.

National Juries award grants to the most innovative school projects in each country and, later on, will evaluate which of the schools has made the best use of the grant to implement its project – this will be considered the National Winner Project.

The International Jury will then assess the National Winner Projects (one per country) and will choose one of them to be the International Winner Project.
